1. **PRIZE.** The First Prize is \$20,000. At the judge's discretion, merit awards may be awarded.

2. **JUDGE.** Warwick Brown

How to enter:

3. (a) Complete an application on the official entry form or a true replica thereof.

(b) Entry forms are available either as hard copy or can be downloaded from our website.

(c) The entry fee is \$35 per entry or \$20 for financial WSA members. Artists may submit more than one entry provided the entry fee is paid for each separate entry submitted. Please use separate forms for each entry. Payment by cheque with entryform or direct deposit to WSA bank a/c (details below) or provide details of your Visa/Mastercard . Please include your full name in bank details/Reference column when paying by direct deposit.

(d) One only, unmounted, clear coloured A4 photograph or digital print of your work with the top clearly indicated is to be submitted with completed entry form. Diptych / triptych images must fit on one page only. Photographs will not be returned.

(e) Send the completed entry and photo to: PO Box 1018. Hamilton 3240. to arrive by the closing date below.

4. **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

MEDIA. Two-dimensional works to be on board, canvas or paper, in any media and may include prints, photos, collage.

SIZE OF WORK. (Inclusive of frame) Maximum 1500mm x 1500mm; Depth 50mm
Work may contain no more than THREE separate pieces, provided the total area of the work does not exceed the 1500mm x 1500mm size.

HANGING. Please note that works are hung on black screens. Framed work or works on stretchers must have sufficient support at the rear to take substantial screw eyes for hanging. Unframed works on paper are easily damaged. Consideration regarding re-inforcement at hanging points is essential.

ANY ENTRY WHICH DOES NOT MEET THESE CRITERIA WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

5. **WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SELECT ANY WORK TO BE HUNG FOR EXHIBITION.** There will be an initial prejudging process from which semi-finalists will be chosen to forward their works for final selection and hanging. The exhibition is to be hung at the Hamilton Gardens Pavilion for the duration of the Gardens Festival.

6. **FINALISTS.** All entrants will be advised by late November as to whether or not they have been chosen to present their work for the next judging stage. All finalists will be advised whether they have been chosen for the exhibition. All entrants will receive a complimentary ticket to the opening.

7. **ALL WORKS MUST BE FOR SALE.** Prices are to be shown on the entry form and must be GST Inclusive. No works will be sold prior to the judge's announcement at the opening ceremony. Our commission rate will be 40%, GST inclusive. Where appropriate, the artist must include their agent's fee in the selling price. The sponsor reserves the right to purchase the winning work.

8. The sale of any works shall not be deemed complete until the receipt and clearance of funds to the WSA bank account. Commission deduction and artist payments shall be made at the conclusion of the exhibition.

9. All work is to be signed, dated and clearly labelled. Include print and edition number if applicable.

10. **Entries close..... 8 October 2010**

11. **JUDGE'S DECISION WILL BE FINAL.** No correspondence will be entered into.

12. **WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO REPRODUCE THE WORKS FOR ADVERTISING PURPOSES** in any form, for any catalogue or other publicity of our choosing. There will be no entitlement to royalty or other payment for any reproduction.

13. **OPEN** to any New Zealand citizen or anyone who holds permanent residency. Any person under 15 years of age at the closing date for entries should show birthdate on entry form.

14. **WE TAKE ALL CARE, BUT ACCEPT NO RESPONSIBILITY** for any loss or damage which may occur. Artists should arrange their own insurance.
